1. Academic Excellence:

❖ Results:

- ❖ *Our 12th batch of 10th std std. students achieved 100% results. Out of 97 students, following is the statistics;*
- ❖ *Total Distinctions:- Above 85% & above = 27 students*
- ❖ *Above 90%- 28 students in Science, 19 students in Math, 25 students in Social, 23 students in English, 8students in Sanskrit, 7 students in Hindi and 14 students in Kannada.*
- ❖ *Between 80 to 90% - 14 students in Science, 11 students in Math, 16 students in Social and 40 students in English.*
- ❖ *Students scored Centum in Social Science, Math & Sanskrit.*
