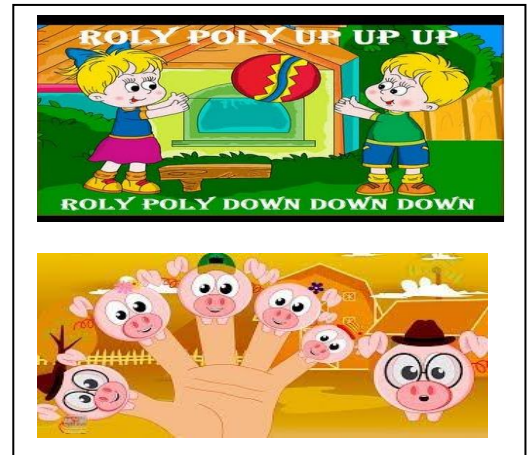
NEWSLETTER FOR THE MONTH OF AUGUST 2019-20.

- ❖ Made stick puppet.

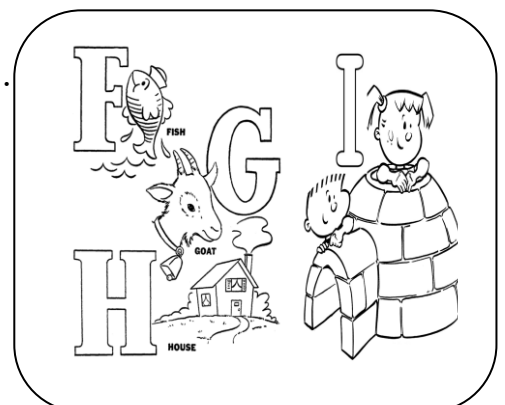
